

## **The Climate Crisis in the (English) Classroom**

(A Stuttgart Change Labs Project, see <https://www.project.uni-stuttgart.de/changelabs/en/>)

How does the climate crisis prompt us to rethink interculturality and ideas of global citizenship? This project bridges the gap between literary, media and cultural studies (ecocriticism), the English classroom (education for sustainable development) and political practice (eco-activism). It combines academic, educational and activist approaches to the climate crisis in the following formats:

- 1) a **virtual lecture series** addressing ecoliterature and environmental humanities (6 sessions, Thursdays, 8 p.m., on Webex, from late November 2021– late January 2022
- 2) a day-long **online workshop** with engaged educational and cultural actors (December 10, 2021);
- 3) development of a **learning tool** for use in the digital classroom (January–February 2022), based on ideas and concepts generated in the workshop and the lecture series.
