Digital Tools in Literature Classes - A Digital Approach to Teaching Adichie's Short Fiction

In this keynote presentation, we investigate how digital tools can contribute to an in-depth understanding of the short story "The Thing Around Your Neck". This involves the aspects of interactivity, digital text production, generative AI, and instant feedback, serving as a basis for general reflections on the potential and challenges of digital tools in literature lessons.

The lecture will be followed by a Q&A session with a focus on Chimamanda Ngozi Adichie's "The Thing Around Your Neck". (Future) teachers will have the opportunity to bring their own questions and input. Participants are cordially invited to the short story in advance.
