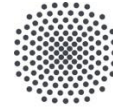

# Go Digital at Stuttgart and Bergen!

Successful applicants will receive a monthly stipend of €1,100. The program requires a minimum stay of three months, with funding available for up to an entire semester (maximum of five months). At the University of Stuttgart, participants will have the chance to enroll in courses offered by the Departments of English and American Studies, earning ECTS credits if needed. Additionally, they will engage in activities organized under the Stuttgart **Born Digital** project.

Advanced MA students working on their theses will gain access to research colloquia, where they can present their projects, participate in collaborative workshops, and benefit from co-supervision by Stuttgart faculty. Furthermore, successful applicants will contribute to the **Living Glossary of Digital Narratives**—an online repository of terminology for fields related to the creation and study of digital narratives. Participants will have the chance to develop entries for pre-selected keywords, potentially resulting in their first peer-reviewed publication.

The *BWS plus* project “Born Digital” is carried out by the Baden-Württemberg Stiftung as part of the Baden-Württemberg-STIPENDIUM programme for university students.
