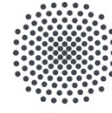

Apply for a ***Baden-Württemberg-STIPENDIUM for University Students*** by submitting a motivation letter (2 pages max.), your CV, and an academic transcript (as one single pdf file) to Joseph.Tabbi@uib.no and Scott.Rettberg@uib.no by

01 September 2024!

Successful applicants will receive a stipend of 1.100,- Euro / month. The required minimum stay is three months, but students can be funded for a whole semester (up to five months max.). At Stuttgart University, students will have the opportunity to participate in courses offered at the [Departments of English and American Studies](#) and gain ECTS if needed. They will further participate in events organised as part of the Stuttgart [Born Digital](#) project. Advanced MA students working on their research theses will be admitted to research colloquia, where they can present their projects in joint events and workshops, and be co-supervised by colleagues at Stuttgart. Successful applicants will have the opportunity to contribute to a *Living Glossary of Digital Narratives*, an online terminology base for disciplines related to the crafting and study of digital narrative. Participants in the program will have the opportunity to create entries relating to pre-selected keywords. This could be your first peer-reviewed publication!
