Go Digital at Stuttgart and Bergen!



- Are you an **MA- / MEd-student** studying English literatures and cultures or Digital Humanities?
- Are you interested in **digital narratives**?
- Would you like to **spend up to a semester (3-5 months)** at the **University of Bergen** between January and June/July 2026?

Apply for a ***Baden-Württemberg-STIPENDIUM for University Students*** by submitting a motivation letter (2 pages max.), your CV, and an academic transcript (as one single pdf file) to sibylle.baumbach@ilw.uni-stuttgart.de by **15 September 2025!**

Successful applicants will receive a stipend of 1.200,- Euro / month. The required minimum stay is three months, but students can be funded for a whole semester (i.e. up to five months max.). At Bergen University, students will have the opportunity to participate in courses offered at the [Department of Linguistic, Literary, and Aesthetic Studies](#) and gain ECTS if needed. They will further have access to resources, research colloquia, and events of the [Centre for Digital Narrative \(CDN\)](#), a Norwegian Centre of Research Excellence, and participate in events organised as part of the Stuttgart [Born Digital](#) project. Advanced MA students working on their research theses will be admitted to research colloquia where they can present their projects, participate in joint events and workshops, and be co-supervised by colleagues from the CDN. Successful applicants will have the opportunity to contribute to the *Living Glossary of Digital Narratives*, an online terminology base for disciplines related to the crafting and study of digital narrative. This could be your first peer-reviewed publication!
