Successful candidates will receive a generous stipend of €1,100 per month. The program requires a minimum stay of three months, but funding is available for up to five months, allowing for a full semester of academic immersion.

At the University of Bergen, you will:

- Engage in courses at the Department of Linguistic, Literary, and Aesthetic Studies, earning ECTS credits if needed.
- Access the cutting-edge resources, research colloquia, and events at the Centre for Digital Narrative (CDN), a Norwegian Centre of Research Excellence.
- Participate in dynamic events organized as part of the Stuttgart **Born Digital** project.

Advanced Master's students working on their research theses will gain exclusive admission to research colloquia, where they can:

- Present their projects to a scholarly audience.
- Collaborate in joint workshops and events.
- Benefit from co-supervision by esteemed colleagues from the CDN.

Additionally, participants will contribute to the **Living Glossary of Digital Narratives**, an online terminology repository for disciplines centred on digital storytelling. Crafting entries for pre-selected keywords, that could lead to your first peer-reviewed academic publication!
