Arrival:

Frankfurt Airport to Stuttgart Main Station

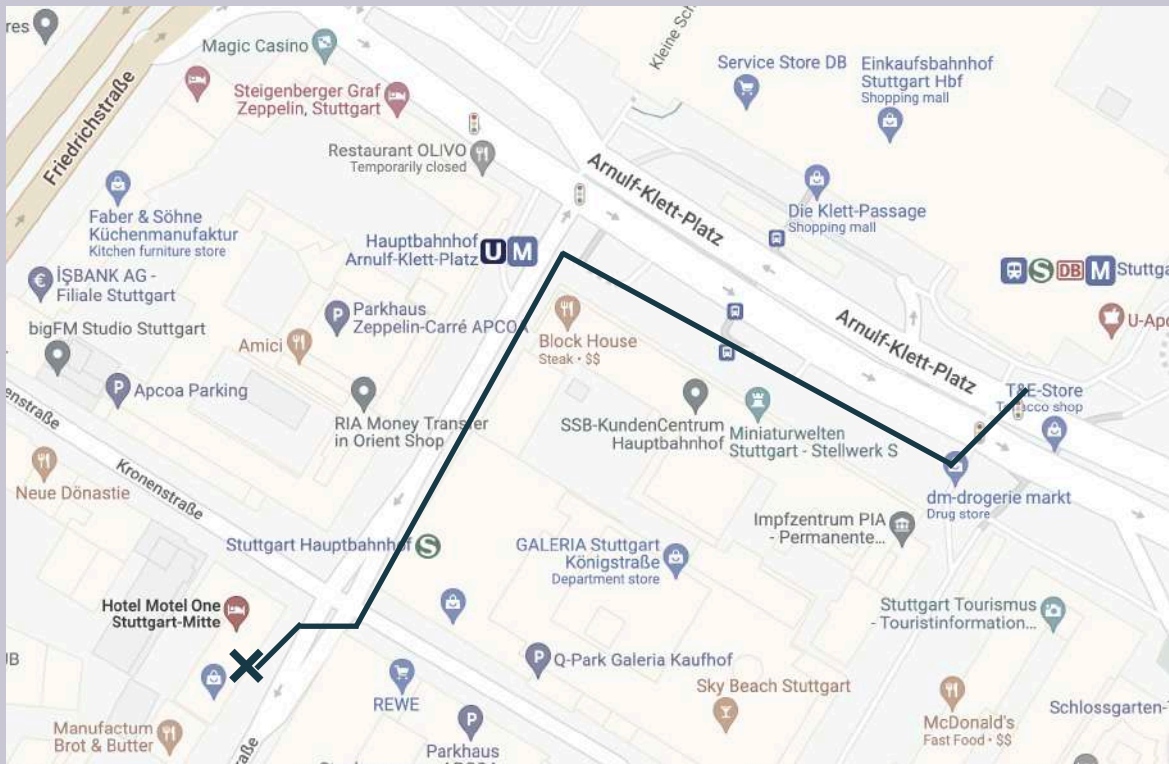


Make your way to the **train station** across from **Terminal 1**. Find a **ticket machine** and select **Stuttgart Hauptbahnhof (HBF) or Stuttgart Main Station** as your destination. Trains (called ICE) should run at least **twice an hour** and, if you find a **direct route**, should take you about **1h 15 min**. In case of a **change-over**, the overall train ride will take **between 1h 10min and 2h 8min**, depending on the route.

Tip: Before you travel, you can already check the train schedule and even purchase a ticket in advance on this website <https://www.bahn.com/en>

Arrival: Hotel Motel One Stuttgart Mitte

Exiting the **main station**, you will arrive at the **crossing**. Cross the street and turn right, walk until you reach the restaurant **Block House**. Turn left and follow the street until the next **intersection**. Cross the street, turn right, cross the street again. From there, walk left until you reach the entrance of **Hotel Motel One** marked X.



Tip: In this area, Google Street View has not been updated since 2008, so it is very unreliable.

Logistics:

Buying a Ticket for the U-Bahn (Underground)

Look for a ticket machine at any station. Choose your destination and it will recommend the cheapest ticket to you.

A few notes on relevant tickets:

1) Short rides (up to 3 stops) should cost you **1,60€**. These tickets **need to be validated** by inserting it in one of the **orange machines** in the image to the left. They can be found on train stations and on U-Bahnen.

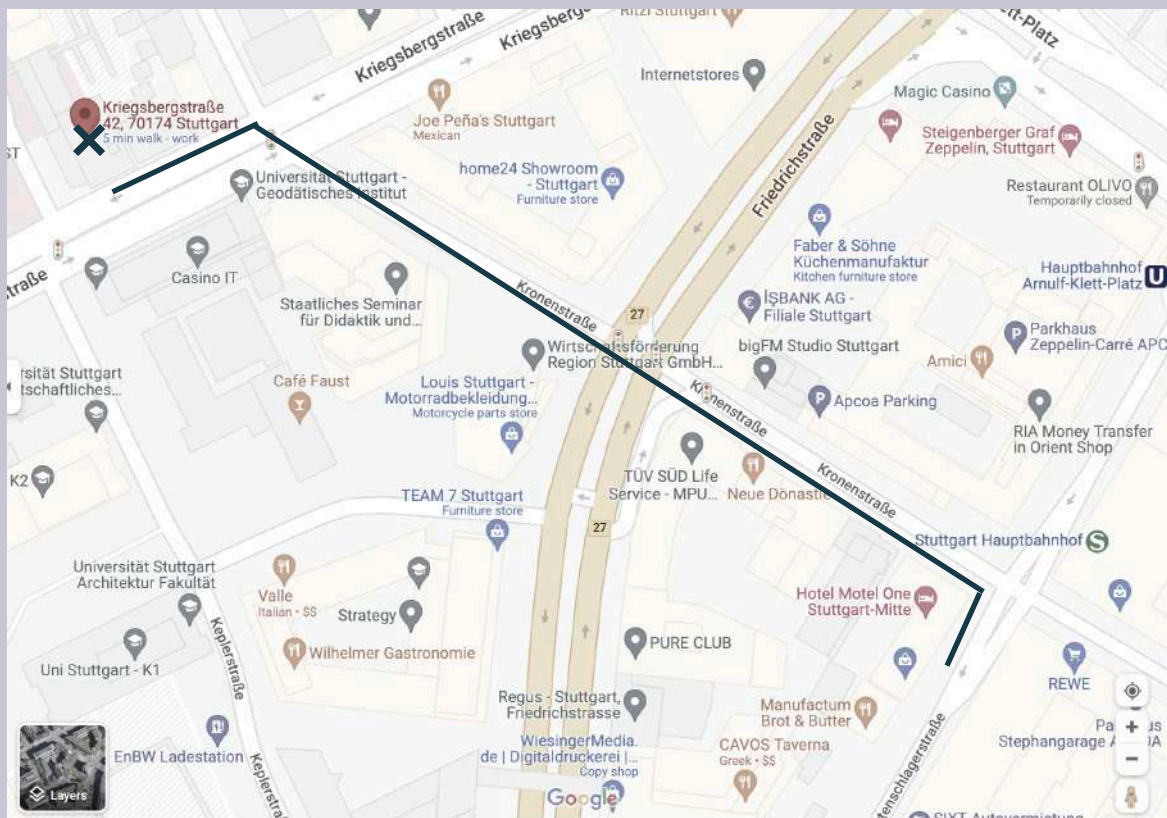


2) If you take more than one train ride in central Stuttgart on a day, it might be cheaper to get the **day pass for 5,60€**. These tickets **do not need to be validated**.

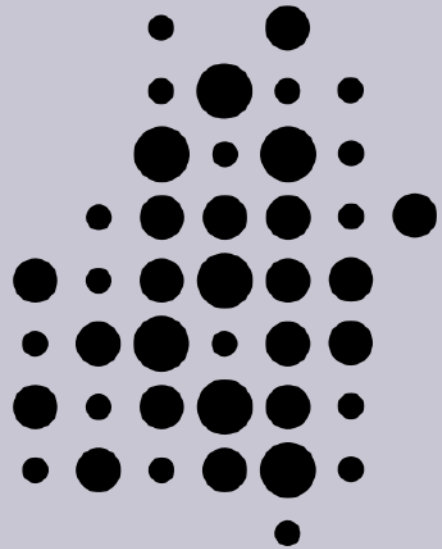
3) If you take more than one train ride in central Stuttgart and travel in the same **group of up to 5 people** for the entire day, it might be cheaper to get the **group day pass for 11,20€**. These tickets **do not need to be validated**.

Locations: Baden-Württemberg Stiftung

After exiting the **hotel**, go left until the **intersection**. Turn left and walk straight until the next **junction**. Cross it, and keep walking straight ahead until the following **intersection**. Cross the street and walk to your left until you see the **Baden-Württemberg Stiftung** to your right.

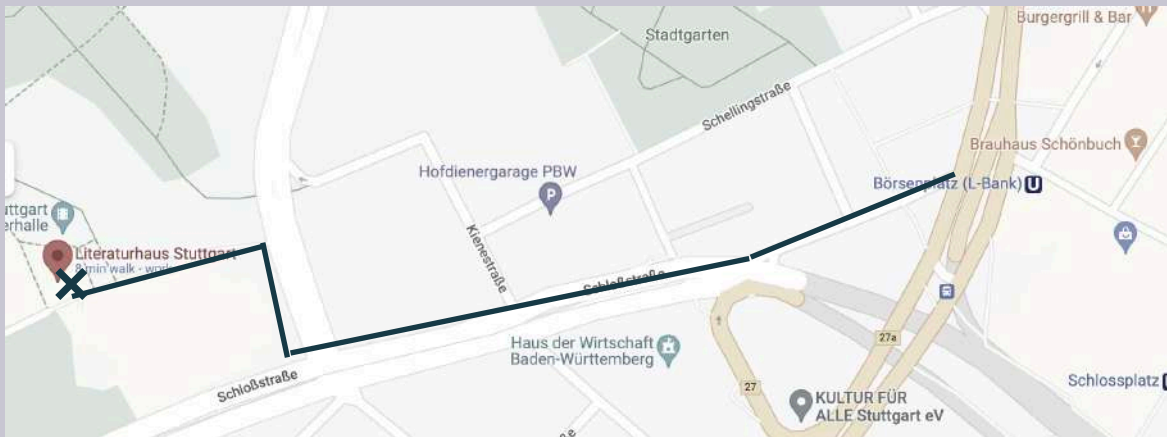

Locations: Literaturhaus Stuttgart

Route 1 - A 15 Minute Walk

Exit the **hotel** and walk right until you see the restaurant **Senzanome** to your left. Walk right until you get to a **crossing**. Cross the street, and walk left past the **fountain** until you get to a small street situated between the **Volksbank** building (left) and the **L-Bank** building (right). Walk down this street.





Walk down this street until it merges with a larger street. Follow this street until it meets **Büchsenstraße**. Cross this street and turn right. Walk until you see the building **Hegel-Saal** to your left. Take the road to the left of the building until you reach the entrance to the **Literaturhaus** on your right.

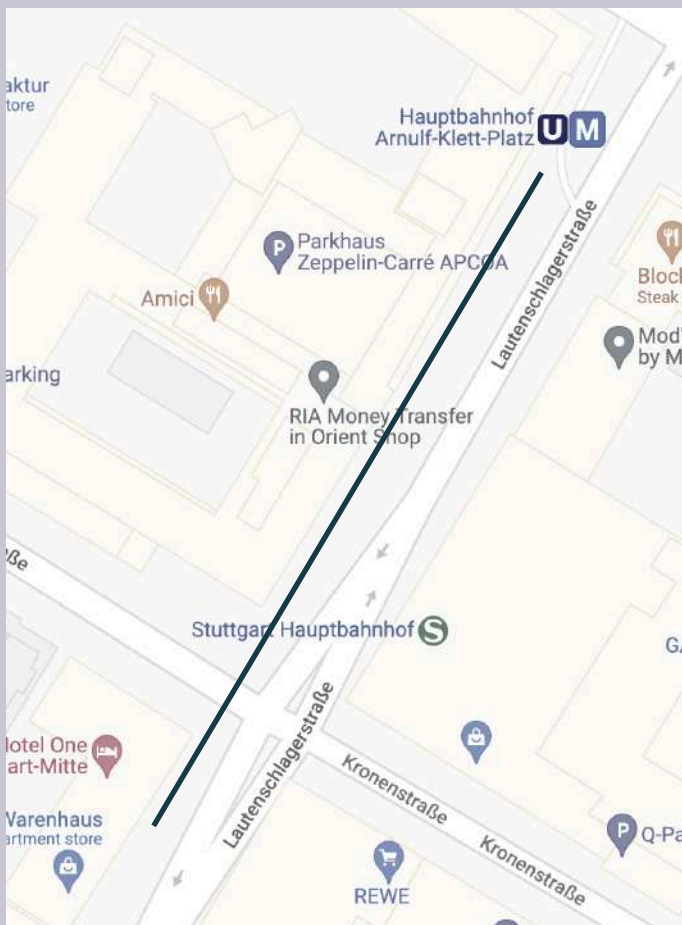

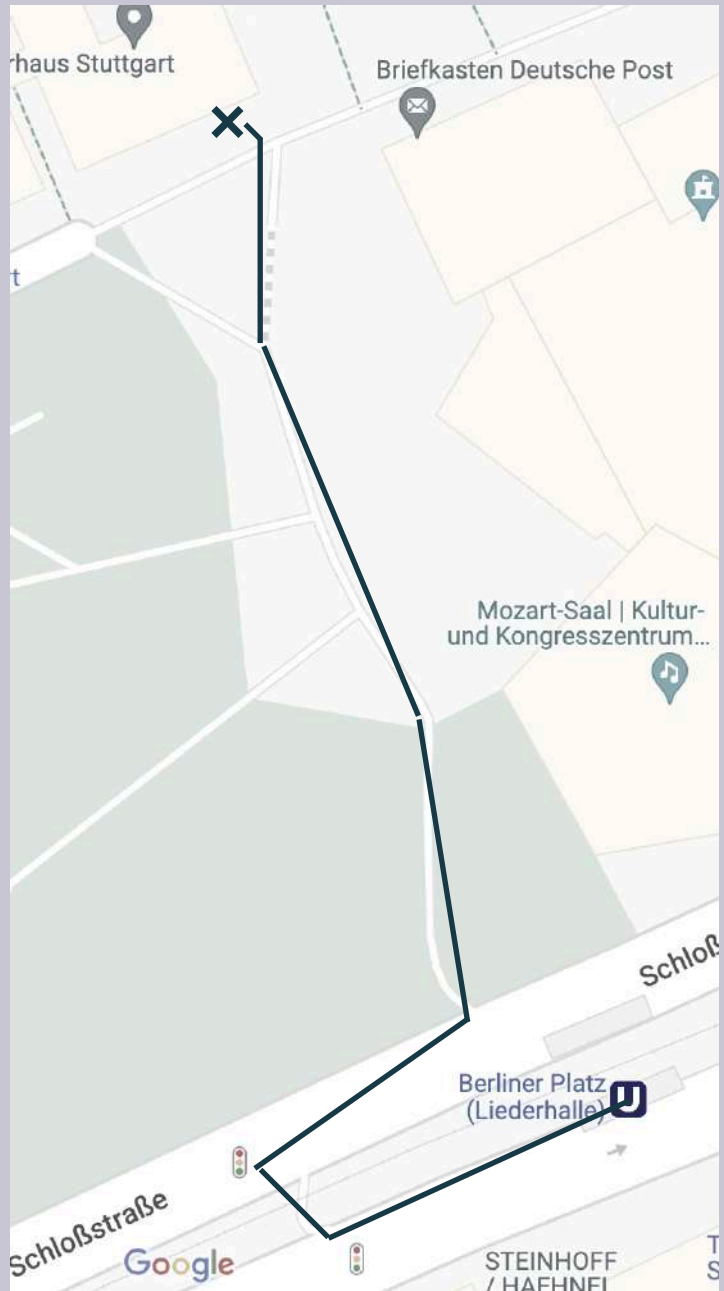

Route 2 - 6 Minute Public Transport



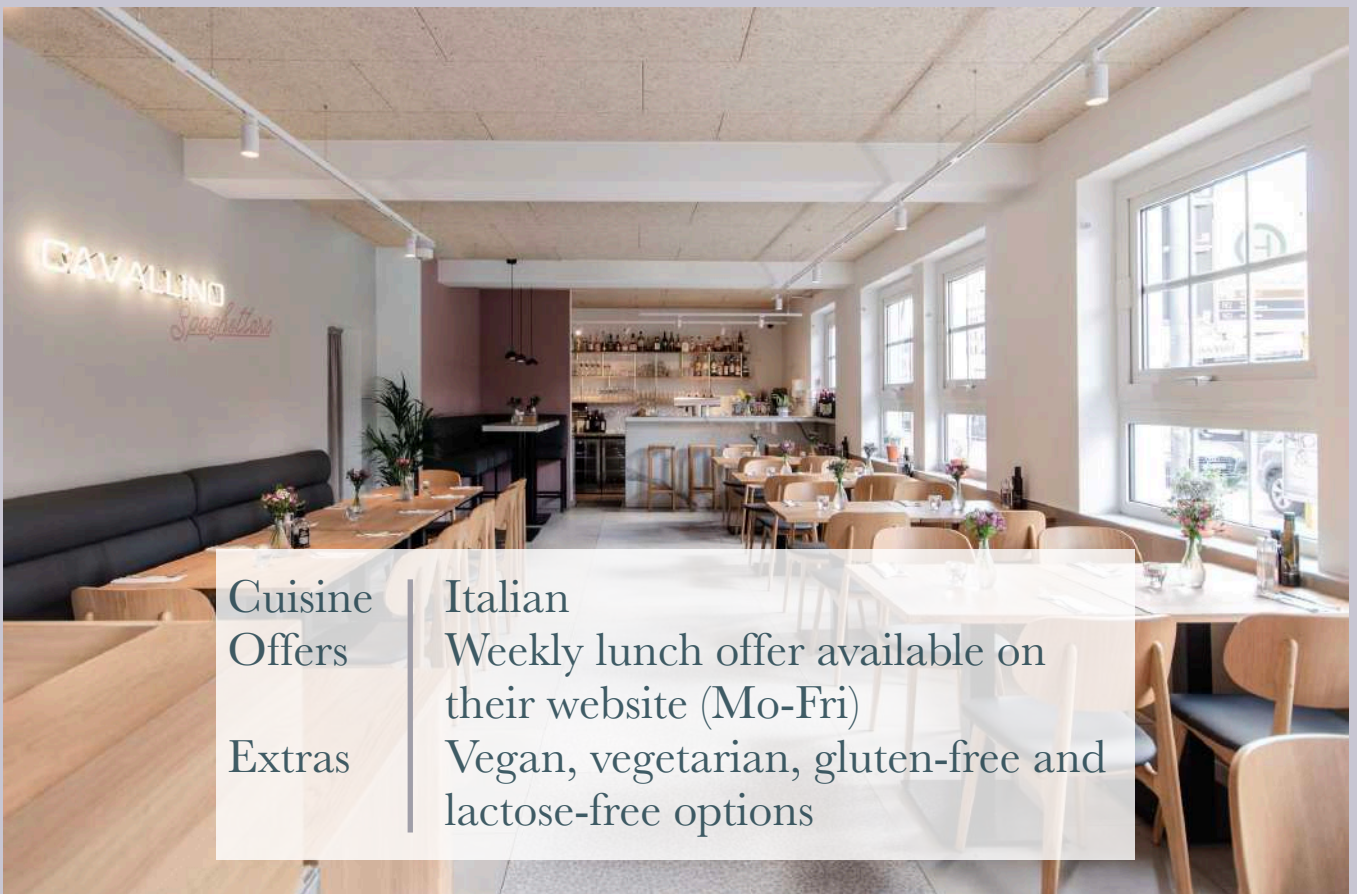
Exit the **hotel** and turn left. Walk straight ahead until you get to the **escalator** that leads underground to the **U-Bahn** (the German Underground). Take the **U14 Mühlhausen** and get off at the second stop called **Berliner Platz**.

Get off the train at **Berliner Platz**, cross the **train tracks** and walk through the **park** next to the road. Walk past the **Mozart-Saal** to your right until you arrive at the **Literaturhaus**.



Tip: If the Literaturhaus is your only train destination of the day, getting a short ride ticket for each journey for 1,60€ will be the cheapest option.

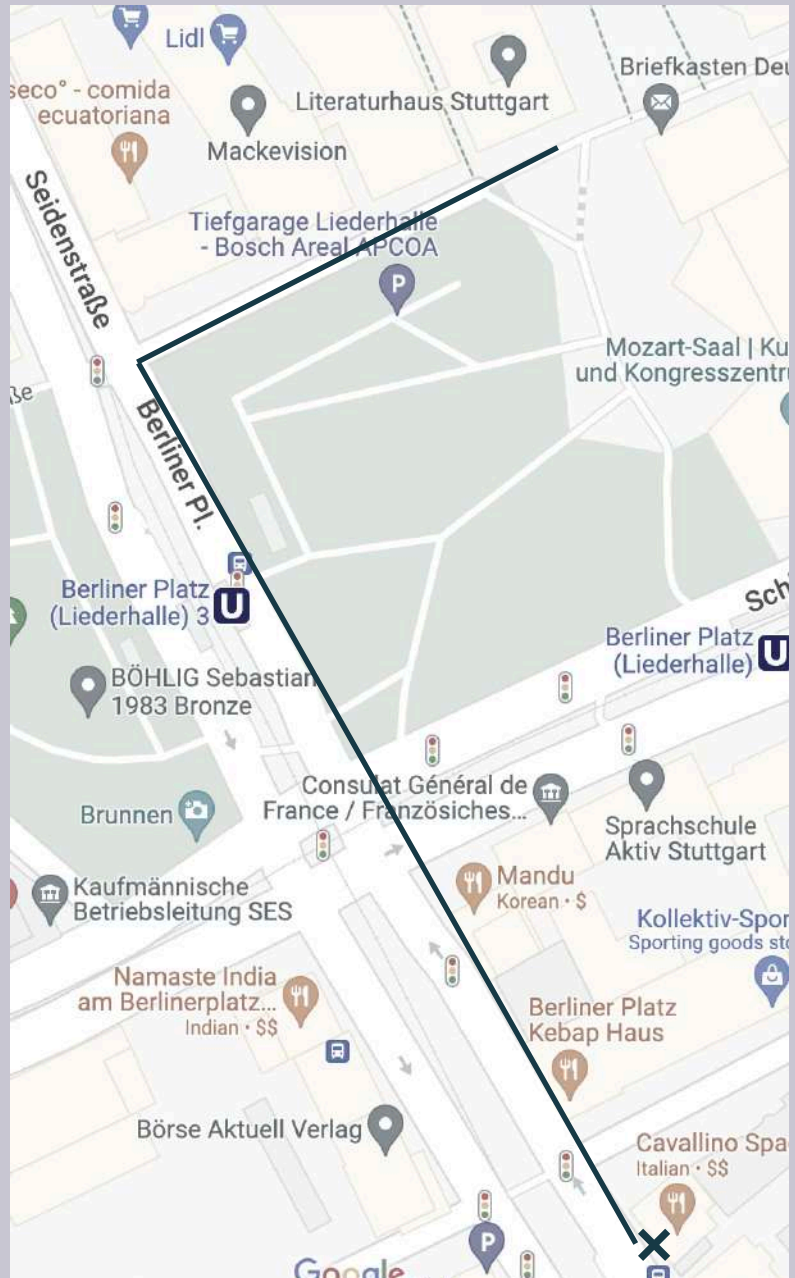

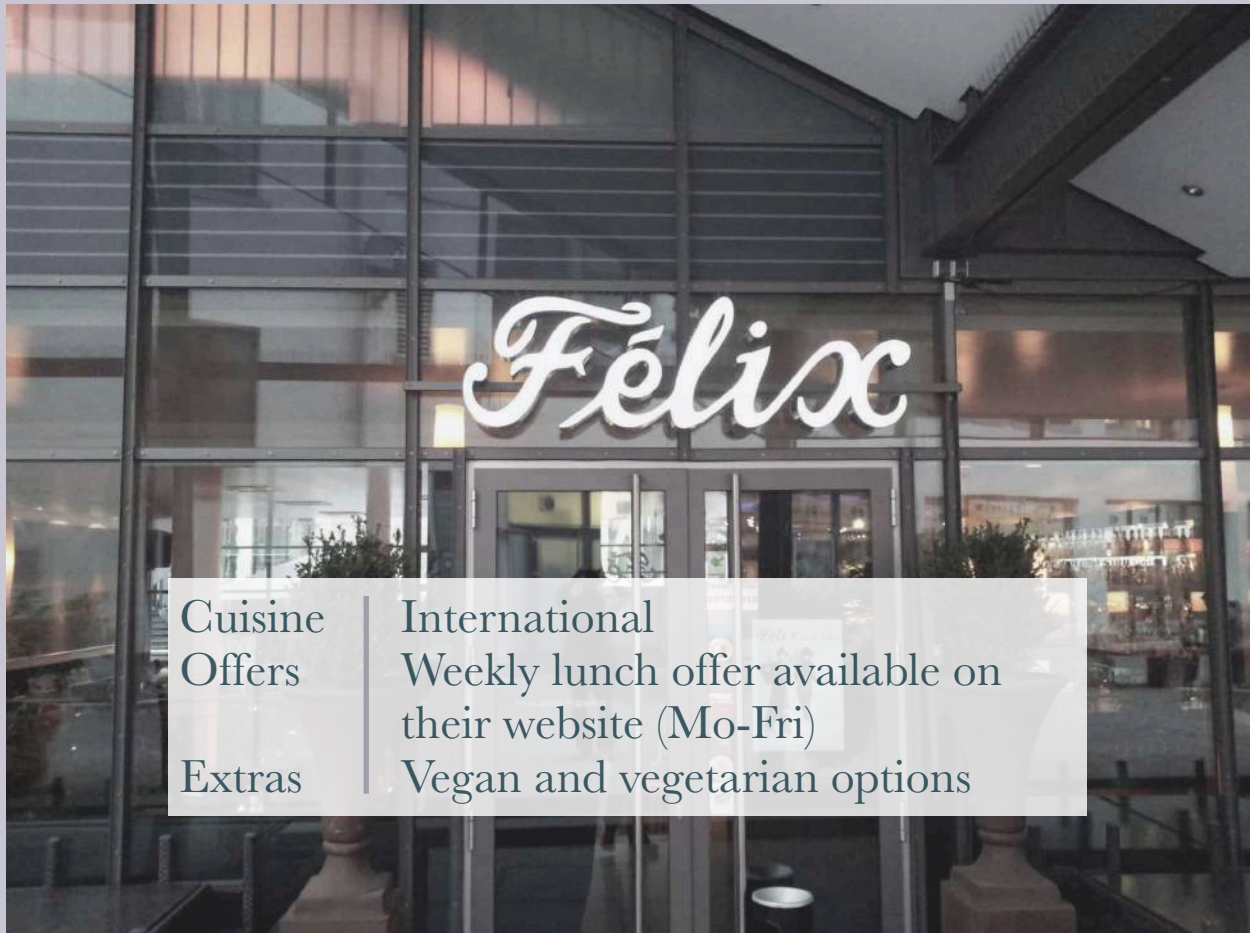

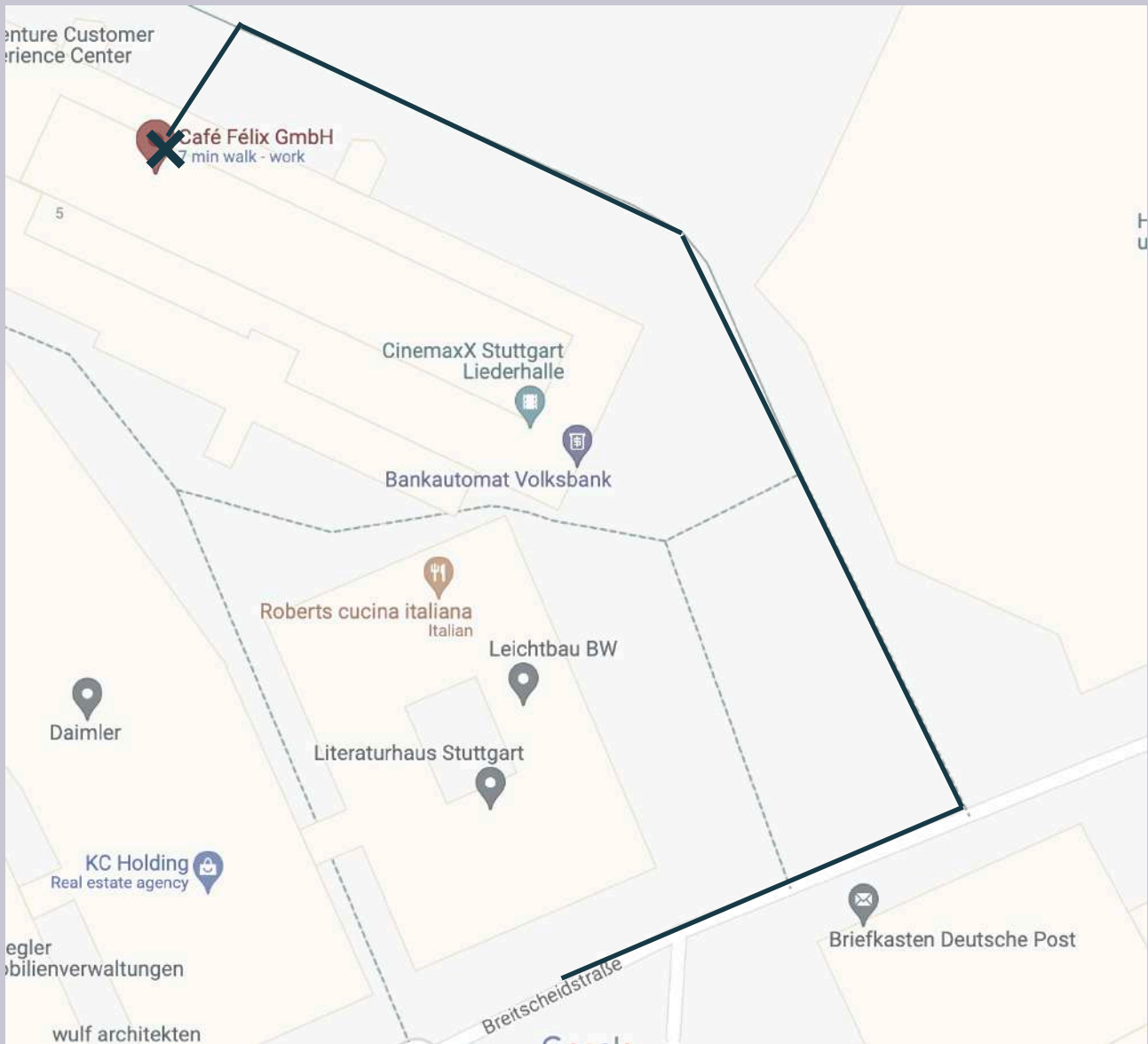

Take that path around until you see **Café Felix** to your left.



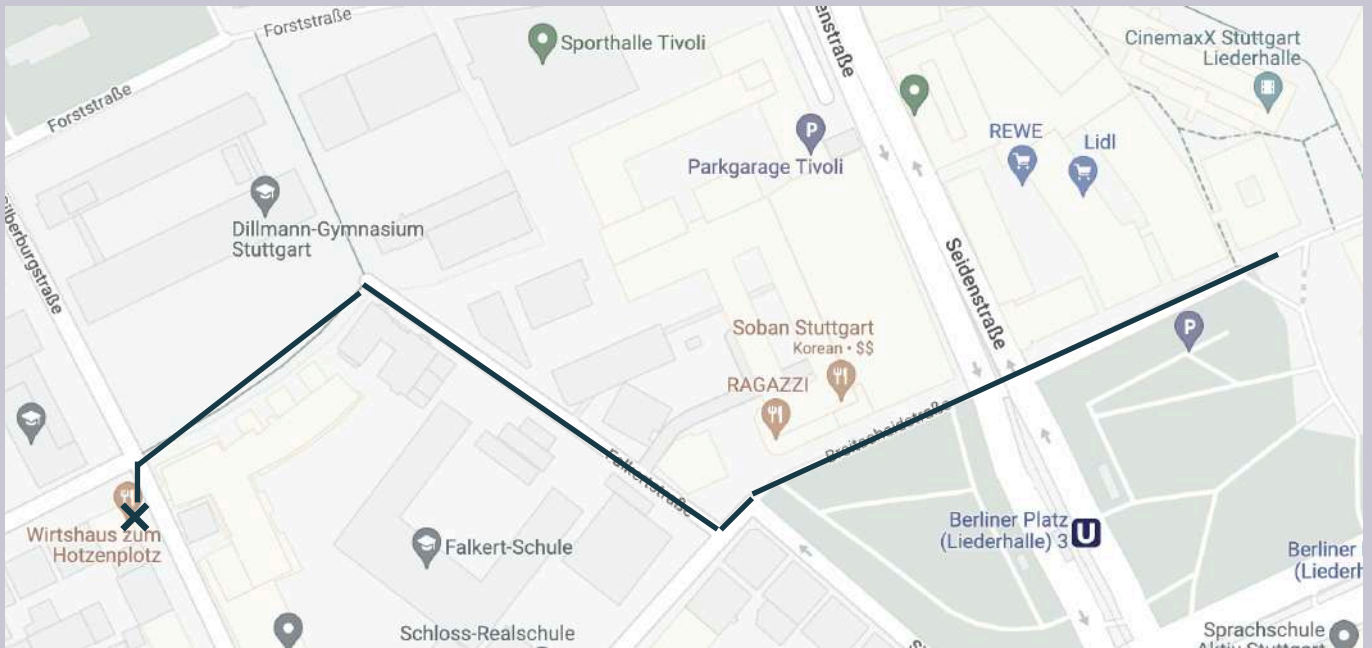

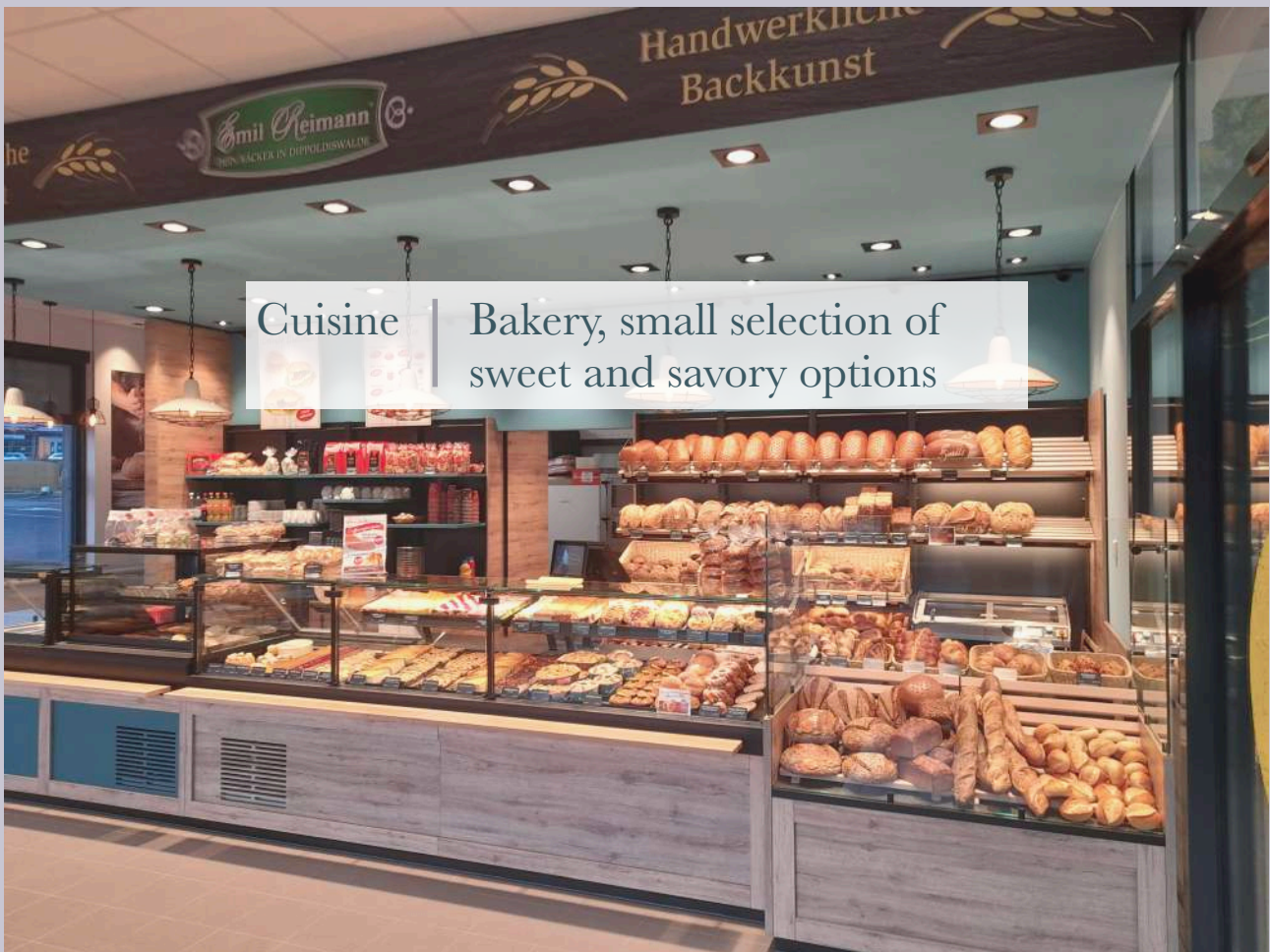

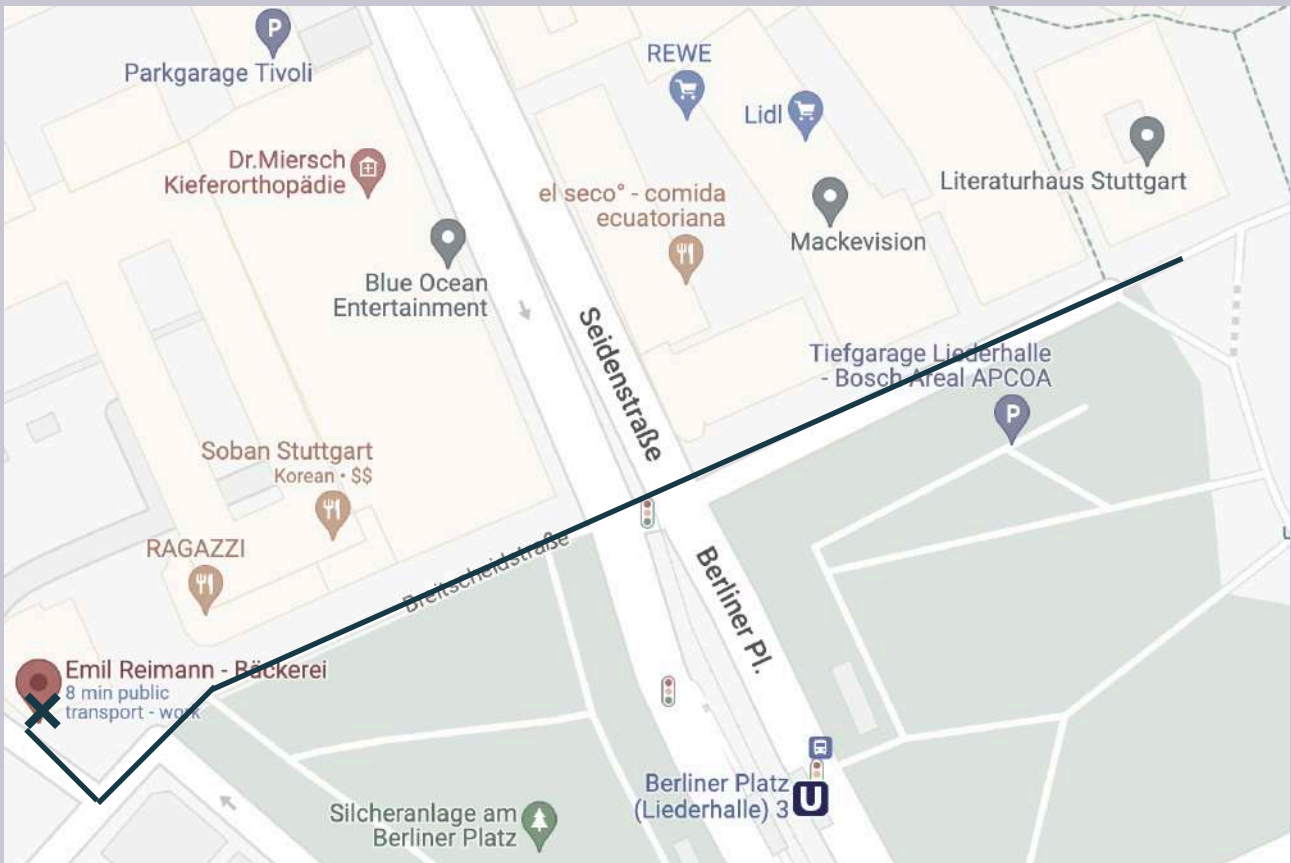

Turn left again where you will see **Wirtshaus zum Hotzenplotz** to your right.

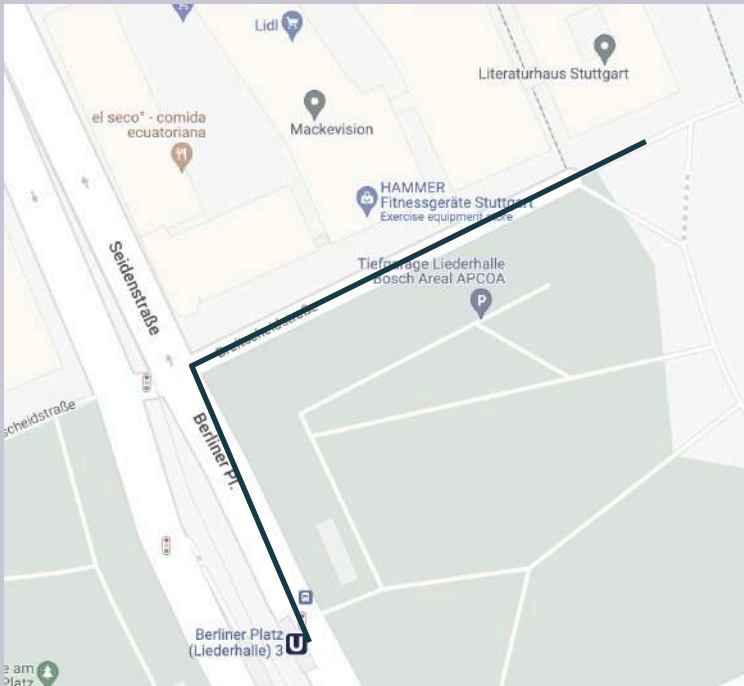

Exit the **Literaturhaus**. Turn right and follow the path until you reach the **end of the park** to your left. Turn left and walk down the street until you reach the **station**. Take the **U4 Holderlinplatz** and get off at the third stop called **Holderlinplatz**.

Get off the train at **Holderlinplatz**. Walk up the street in the direction from which your train came until you reach the next **intersection**. Turn left, then right at the next **junction**. Walk straight until you see **Cupcakes and Bagels** on your right.
